NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING **APRIL 28, 2022**

April 28th is the National Day of Mourning for workers killed on the job. Workers across Canada will take pause to remember and reflect on those who have lost their lives or suffered injury due to their work. This day holds significant importance to our Union after the tragic and preventable loss of one of our own in 2020.

The day highlights the importance of safe work and our responsibility and commitment to continue the pursuit of safety in the workplace and the prevention of further tragedies.

Traditionally on this day, public ceremonies are held at 11 am to honour lives lost and those suffering from occupational disease. Join fellow Union members at an event in your community. If you are faced with unsafe work, please refuse that work. If the employer doesn't remedy that unsafe work, call WorkSafe to report it.
