- Inform all involved parties regarding responsibility and their tasks in connection with the DDIs.
- Perform” After Action Review” (AAR) after completing operations and update electronically the DDI as instructed by the DSL with lessons learned for future use.
- Analyze operation results and follow up nonconformity in summary meetings.
- Create and maintain ownership to the Quality Performance process among the crew onboard.
- Observe any non-compliance and immediately report these to his/her superior.
- Ensuring that all work is done safely and professionally in compliance with requirements in the management system and actively take part in safety meetings and other meetings.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
