



Deck Officer (OOW)

Purpose

The purpose of this function is to Sea Keeping Watch command under the responsibility of the Captain and Chief Officer of the vessel.

Vessel: Victory-G

Length of rotation for employment: 6 weeks

Place in the organization

The Navigating Officer:

- Is accountable towards the Master/Captain of the vessel.
- Is a substitute for the Chief Officer in case of absence.

Job Description

The job description of the Deck Officer (OOW) includes:

- Executing all possibilities.
- Executing activities assigned by the Captain or Chief Mate.
- To comply with and to make sure that the laws, the mining regulations, the Company's Safety Management System and the HSE Manual are observed by the vessel's Personnel.
- Coordinating and delegating activities on board the Captain or Chief Mate and the Crew.
- Motivating and stimulating the vessel's Personnel.
- Maintaining contact with the Master, Chief Mate, and Crew.
- Supporting the Master or Chief Mate about the execution of the policy.
- The management and maintenance of the safety and fire extinguishers under supervision of Chief Mate.
- The management of the vessel's hospital and medication under supervision of Chief Mate.
- Keeping the vessel's administration up to date under supervision of Chief Mate.
- Keeping the nautical books up to date under supervision of Chief Mate.

4.1 Responsibilities

The Deck Officer (OOW) is responsible for:

- The vessel and the Crew under management.
- The observance of the laws, mining regulations, the Company's Safety Management System, and the HSE Manual by the vessel's Personnel.
- The correct execution of the assigned activities

Authorities

The Deck Officer (OOW) is authorized to:

- Delegate activities.
- Have authorities necessary for the execution of the function of 2nd Navigating Officer.
