Purpose

The purpose of this function is to perform maintenance and activities on the vessel and to maintain machines, equipment, and tools, assigned by the Captain/Master or Chief Engineer.

Place in the organization

The 3rd Engineer:

- Is accountable towards the Chief and 2nd Engineer.
- Replaces the 2nd Engineer in case of absence.

Job Description

The job description of the 3rd Engineer includes:

- Executing assigned activities.
- Cleaning.
- Executing activities on deck.
- Performing reparations and maintenance on board of vessel under the responsibility of Chief Engineer.
- Handling and managing the technical administration under supervision of 2nd Engineer.
- Keeping various journals up to date under supervision of 2nd Engineer.

Responsibilities

The 3rd Engineer is responsible for:

- The correct execution of assigned activities.
- The correct execution of reparations and maintenance.

Authorities

The 3rd Engineer is authorized to:

- Execute reparations and maintenance on board.
- Independently execute mentioned duties and assigned activities.

Training and experience

Minimally the following training/experience is required for this function:

- Valid certificate of competence
- Valid examination papers.
- Relevant work experience.
- Knowledge of electronics and hydraulics.
- Knowledge of the English language.
